## **Kelowna's Weninger at the top of its game**

This year the design/build company was honoured with a coveted Gold Tommie award in the category Excellence in Single Family Detached Home \$1.5 Million. The recipient of the award is the Inuksuk Lodge in Feathertop Estates at Big White Ski Resort.

Company co-owners Pau-line and Marlin Weninger describe the project as a true dream getaway. Built on a steep slope the four-bedroom, fourlevel 5,000 square foot lodge is a luxury ski-in-ski out vacation

Like all the projects Marlin Weninger designs, he started with learning everything he could about his client's needs. The biggest challenge Weninger

faced was the site itself.
"We had a limited building envelope on the site because of

With the design completed, Weninger submitted an exact quote and began the building process. Many factors went into making the home unique, he says, including high lofted ceilings, three natural stone fireplaces, a large theatre room, in-floor heating, heated outdoor decks, a three-car garage and a

also boasts a steam shower as well as an infrared sauna. Another eye-catching feature in the home is the kitchen with its solid wood cabinets. Bars in the great room and games room match the rustic wood of the kitchen.

"I grew up with construc-Weninger says, noting that his father, Ron, and his uncles were in construction.

Ron Weninger provided for his family by building homes and he ensured that each of his sons learned the trade. Marlin studied design and drafting and provided the family businesses with building plans. After a brief hiatus doing what he calls "regular jobs" he decided it was time to start his own company.

In 1991 a passion for skiing drew Weninger Construction's attention to the then undeveloped potential of Big White Ski Resort. The company became one of the first contractors to build a luxury ski chalet in the Snow Pine Estates subdivision. Weninger Construction then spent the next decade building custom chalets, and the award winning 22 unit Grizzly Ski Lodge at Big White.

Weninger says that he hap-pened into the business through the family connection but what kept him in is a love of what he does. Design is a particular passion and talent. Using a 3D program for both new building and renovations, clients have the op-portunity to see their completed house conceptually before the earth is even turned.

"I strive to give the custom-er what they want," Weninger says. "And I'm very good at maximizing a site for how much building can fit on it. For com-mercial and condominium projects I know how to get the best use out of the property. When you're buying land for a condo project and your floor ratios are set by the city and land is so expensive, you want to squeeze

every square foot out of that building that you can."

Although Weninger is known for a diversified range of projects including commer-cial and residential, both new and renovations, he admits that custom high-end homes are his favourite. They provide a tre-mendous outlet for creativity and innovation, he says.

"Our main goal is to satisfy the customer and make them very happy with the job no matter what the job is."

Weninger Construction & Design is also no stranger to development. In early 2000 the company designed the environmentally friendly Black Mountain Golf Course and the surrounding 750 home master plan community called Black Moun-

tain Golf Community. Weninger has built several homes in the subdivision. The company is also involved in developing Feathertop, a single family community at Big White. About half a dozen homes have been built if the development where Weninger offers design/ build services along with home

Weninger says he is doing exactly what he loves and has no plans to change. His wife, Pauline points out that the company is also well known for its renovations and its 3D design work that allows people to see exactly what a proposed renovation will look like.

"It's really nice when people

can visualize it," she says.

Pauline and Marlin Weninger with his parents, Ron and Elfrieda Weninger, founded their company in 1989 and incorporated in 1991 but the Weninger name has always been associated with construction in the Kelowna area.
